


Trading volumes on the Polish power market


PolPX spot prices and volumes


BASE Y-13 quotations (PLN/MWh).

Developments in Gas Market

- Exchange based gas trading market launched in December 2012
- Exchange obligation
 - 30 % 2013
 - 40 % 2014
 - √ 55 % 2015
- Release of trading companies from the requirement to have tariffs accepted by ERA (trader trader contracts)
- Release of trading companies from the requirement to have tariffs accepted by ERA for sales to large end customers (25 million m³ in 2013; 2,5 million m³ in 2014)
- Existing gas market barriers (two licences required, import diversification, mandatory reserves)

Bilingual EFET Gas Master Agreement

- Polish Hub Annex
- ❖ Joint EFET & TOE meeting on 2 September, with participation from ERA and GAZ-System (Gas Transmission System Operator)



Next steps - possible cooperation between EFET and TOE (1)

- Abolition of tariff requirement for households
- Lowering of concession charges levied on power trading
 - Currently 0,06 % of sales (appx 0,09 PLN/MWh)
- Establishment of a single day-ahead power fixing at a time coherent with European markets
- Reduction of gas market development obstacles
- The adoption and promotion of the EFET Gas Master Agreement in Poland
 - Joint seminar?
- Implementation of REMIT regulations in the Polish Law
